Participants are highly recommended to purchase travel insurance prior to arrival.




Other Necessary Information

Internet Service

Free Wi-Fi/Internet connection is available in the hotel and event venue. Log-in details will be given upon arrival.

Electricity

In general, a rounded-end stacker with two pins is usually used (type F). The grounding is a two/three pin power plug. The voltage is 220 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. The types of the plug/socket are C, F and G. The G type is not common.



Weather

Indonesia has only two seasons: Rainy Season and Dry Season. Rainy Season is normally in September – February while Dry Season is from March to August. The average temperatures range from 26°Celcius at night and early morning to up to 30°Celcius at noon.



Currency

Indonesia's national currency is Indonesian Rupiah (IDR);1 USD \approx 16.000 IDR. For an updated current exchange rate, you may wish to look at the XE Currency Converter website http://www.xe.com/. You can have your currency across the street of the hotel or you can change in the airport.

Indonesian banknotes come in denominations of IDR1000, IDR2000, IDR5000, IDR10000, IDR20000, IDR50000, and IDR100000. Coins in circulation include IDR1000, IDR500, IDR200, IDR100, and IDR50.
